# **Current class descriptions:**

## 2 1/2 year old Toddler Time Program:

These classes are designed for the very youngest of preschool children. A relaxed non-threatening introduction to the educational environment. The purpose of these classes is to help trigger the development of a child's most basic and fundamental social skills. All children must be 2 by September 30<sup>th</sup> to enroll for fall classes. Children do not need to be potty trained to attend this class.

An additional one-day per week Toddler class will begin early February for these children who turn 2 ½ between October 1st and January 30th.

### 3-year-old program 2-day:

This class is planned for the 3 year old that may not have had any previous preschool experience. The purpose of this class is to help the child develop social skills, become involved in-group activities and make new friends. All children must be 3 years old by September 30<sup>th</sup> and totally potty trained to enroll in this class.

### 3-year-old program 3-day:

These classes are somewhat more comprehensive than the 2-day class due primarily to more time spent in the classroom, as well as slightly more involved activities. The nurturing of basic three-year-old appropriate social skills is still their primary purpose. Children must be 3 years old by September 30<sup>th</sup> and totally potty trained to enroll in this class.

### 4&5-year program 3-day:

These classes are designed for children who are moving up from the 3 year old program as well as for the child who is experiencing preschool for the first time. Classes provide children the opportunity to continue to grow both socially and academically by way of a wide variety of developmentally appropriate hands on activities. Children must be 4 years old by September 30<sup>th</sup> and totally potty trained to enroll in these classes.

#### 4&5 year old program Pre-K Program 4 or 5 day

This class is designed for the younger 5 year old that is ready for an everyday routine but not quite equipped to handle the structure or demands of Kindergarten. The child may be moving up from one of our other programs or joining us for the very first time. These students are challenged to grow socially, and to be exposed to a wide variety of developmentally appropriate readiness activities that are provided via benefits of a consistent daily routine. This class is an excellent final preparation for the child who needs a little more "growing time" before moving onto Kindergarten. The 4-day option is only open in the afternoon program. Children must be 4 years old by May 30th.

# SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMS AVAILABLE AT HUMNS

Preschool Extended Day Enrichment: PEDE is intended to provide three and five-day students the opportunity to be involved in an indepth developmentally appropriate preschool experience based on a wide variety of curriculum topics (including but not exclusive to; art, science, foreign language, movement). Class size is limited. Monday, Wednesday, and Friday classes are available to all 3, 4 and 5 year old students of HUMNS. Each day will offer different activities, so your child has the opportunity to participate in more than one day. This program runs mid-September through the end of the school year. Registration will be held at the same time as registration for regular preschool

independently from normal tuition. Additional information concerning PEDE is available upon request.

**Explorer Program:** The Explorer program is a program designed for 4 and 5 year olds. The children **explore** technology, literature and make friends in this program. They will also be working on literacy, exploring the world and all it has to offer, and they will become young scientists. The program meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays and runs mid-September through the end of the school year. Registration will be held at the same time as registration for preschool classes. The Explorer program is a self-supporting program with tuition paid independently from normal tuition. Additional information concerning the Explorer program is available upon request.

# **Preschool Extended Day Enrichment**
